## CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS CODE ENFORCEMENT COMPLIANCE

- 1. Grass must be mowed and no higher than 8 inches tall on the property. If your yard is separated by a sidewalk, the homeowner is responsible for the grass extended to the street.
- 2. Yards must be well kept, clean and free of loose trash and debris.
- 3. Sidewalks and driveways must be in proper state of repair and free of hazardous conditions.
- 4. Unlicensed or inoperable vehicles are prohibited unless stored inside of a structure.
- 5. All vehicles must be parked on an improved surface. No vehicles are allowed to park on the grass or side yards.
  - a. The HOA guidelines should regulate parking on the street which means no parking on street to and including but not limited to blocking driveways.
  - b. The City of Powder Springs Police Department will enforce parking restrictions.
- 6. All fences must be well maintained; fences are not allowed in front yards.
  - a. NOTE: Corner lots are considered to have two front yards. Residential fences are limited to 6 feet in height.
- 7. Address numbers must be posted and visible from the street.
- 8. Paint and siding must be free of chipping and intact and free of mold or mildew.
  - a. Vacant housing must be secured and maintained.
- 9. Indoor furniture, appliances and trash may not be stored outside.
- 10. Trash must be bagged and placed in trash receptacles.
  - a. Trash carts are allowed on the streetside from 8:00 p.m. the day before collection and must be removed by 9:00 p.m., the day of collection.
  - b. Trash carts must be stored in areas identified pursuant to the Homeowners Association guidelines; however, storing trash carts on the sidewalk is not allowed pursuant to the city's code.
  - c. No dumping is allowed except at approved landfills.
- 11. Landscaping shall be maintained and not overgrown and shall not encroach into street or sidewalks.
- 12. Construction, alterations, and repairs to structures require permits.
  - a. Contact the City of Powder Springs Community Development department to obtain permits.
  - b. The Homeowners Association may have requirements to follow prior to applying to the city.
- 13. The City of Powder Springs Police Department will enforce parking on the streets.

- 14. The City of Powder Springs Code Enforcement will enforce parking on the grass, inoperable vehicles, and vehicle storage.
- 15. Speeding is not allowed in the subdivision. Please contact the City of Powder Springs Police Department to report the same.
- 16. Homeowners are encouraged to register doorbell cameras with the City of Powder Springs Police Department to support safety and to assist in reducing crime within the subdivision.
  - a. FUSUS will allow Police Officers to quickly identify, locate, and apprehend individuals causing harm to our city. This system will alert authorities to the suspect through integrated real-me CCTV camera feeds.
  - b. The Police Department will not have access to your private information.
